Scothern Neighbourhood Plan Review

REFERENDUM VERSION - JUNE 2024

o In 2015 Scothern agreed a Neighbourhood plan for 2015 to 2035 in accordance with the Localism Act 2012.

- o In 2023 the Parish Council undertook a review of the plan in consultation with residents.
- The review took place at the same time as the development of the Central Lincolnshire Local Plan (CLLP).
- The Parish Council were active in objecting to any further developments in Scothern in the CLLP, however this
 was finalised with additional developments for Scothern.
- Therefore, the Neighbourhood Plan has been reviewed in order to collaborate with the developers on these sites and address issues for Scothern.

The Neighbourhood Plan will have real legal weight.

A final version of the Scothern Neighbourhood Plan, if supported at the referendum, will become part of the "Development Plan" and it will enable the Residents supported by the Parish Council to have real influence over planning in the village and it will be a considered by West Lindsey District Council in all planning decisions.

- o Remain a distinctive, rural Parish which treasures its heritage assets.
