The **Scothern Recreation Centre** (SRC) is at the heart of our village and provides the setting for many regular user groups, various events and private hire for parties or meetings.

It is a Registered Charity run by a Committee of Trustees and all the money raised from hirings and events is used to run your village hall.

The Recreation Centre is home to many local clubs and groups including *Scothern Players, Scouts, Beavers, Cubs and Zumba classes, Scothern Cricket Club*. Film nights are held monthly, see local advertising for Flix in the Stix. We run an annual Flower and Produce Show and a Festive Tea and host a very popular Fashion Show.
