SRC continues to thrive, we are now in the position where we are having to turn down some bookings. Some requests have been caused by the recent closure of the Yarborough centre.

Improvements are continuing, we have recently installed fence posts in the car park to stop people driving on the grass.

We continue to host the Cricket Club, The Scothern Players, Zumba, Cubs / Scouts / Beavers, two Sewing clubs and Junior Football Training as well as a good number of ad hoc bookings for parties etc. The cubs in particular are having problems at the moment and may have to close as they cannot recruit helpers. The Spirit of Scothern group continue to raise money by staging events throughout the year, there will be another Fashion Show on the 23rd June ~~even~~ as well as the annual festive tea in December. Flix in the Stix continues to be popular. I'll also mention ever popular the Beer Festival, organised and run by the Cricket Club which will be held at the end of May.

All the money received from hirings is used for the upkeep of the Recreation Centre.

We receive support from the Parish Council for grass cutting and they have recently had a concrete slab laid by the gate.

We have had a few enquiries about the tennis court recently but have had to explain that the court is not viable and we see no prospect of resurrecting it any time soon. The space may also be used for future hall developments.

We continue to receive questions about the play equipment and when it will be replaced, the PC have shown us the proposed options and hopefully they will be available soon. The primary need is for toddler swings and slide to replace those that were removed. Other new equipment may follow.
